Design Style

I describe my Design Style as "Couture with a vintage edge". It embodies a deep commitment to slow fashion and minimising the fashion industry's impact on the environment. My work is thoughtfully designed to enhance the body, whilst being beautifully made with an eye for detail, constantly striving in a small way to emulate past doyens of haute couture design such as Charles James, Valentino and Vivienne Westwood.

I've always been fascinated by cloth. To me it has a language – a narrative of social and personal identity. Equally important is my appreciation of handcrafts; skills passed on from generation to generation. I like to reinterpret handcrafts, to incorporate them into a garment in a way that creatively expresses them and makes them modern and edgy. I use natural fibres, deadstock and repurposed fabric from preloved garments or household linens.

It has always been my vision that to wear a piece of thoughtfully designed and beautifully made clothing carries the legacy of a deeply held tradition that values cloth and clothing. And importantly, through the wearing of each piece, there is a gentle reverence for slow making and quality that endures.

Background and Education

Australian and international fashion styling workshops gave me a deeper understanding of body shapes and how to enhance or accentuate the silhouette. This foundation led me to successfully establish my own fashion styling business in Brisbane, working with private clients, running workshops and hosting and organising major fashion events. After relocating to Perth, I studied a Bachelor of Design (Fashion) at Edith Cowan University, receiving numerous Letters of Commendation from the Executive Dean for Pattern Construction, Draping and Construction and Fashion Project 2 (end of year runway collection). I'm also now studying a Certificate IV in Applied Fashion Design and Technology – South Metropolitan TAFE WA developing skills in electronic fashion design (CLO 3D, Illustrator), pattern grading (Gerber), advanced tailoring techniques and fashion business marketing. My drive is to understand all aspects of fashion design and how to successfully run a fashion business both nationally and internationally.


